

BUNNY BASKET

made with



MATERIALS:

- 2 balls of Big Ribbon Plus (103)
- Amigurumi 100% Cotton in red (S04)
- Crochet hook: L11 (U.S.)/ 8 mm
- Crochet hook size D3 (U.S.)/ 3 mm
- Wool sewing needle

BASKET (X1):

Using Big Ribbon Plus and size L11 hook:

Rows	Stitches to be worked	Total stitches
Start	Magic ring with 6 x	6
1	v in each stitch	12
2	(x + v)* 6 times	18
3	(2x + v)* 6 times	24
4	(3 x + v)* 6 times	30
5	(4 x + v)* 6 times	36
6	(5 x + v)* 6 times	42
7	(6 x + v)* 6 times	48
8	In back loop: x in each stitch	48
9-13	x in each stitch	48
14	15 x + (x + 8 o + 3 f + 2 t + 2 t + x in the first st at the start of the ear) + 6 x + (x + 8 o + 3 f + 2 t + 2 t + x in the first st at the start of the ear) + 25 x (To make the ears)	80
15	● in each stitch	80

Cut and fasten off.

ABBREVIATIONS:

x = Single crochet ● = Slip st ○ = Chain st

t = Half double crochet **T** = Double crochet **f** = Triple crochet

v = Increase: Make 2 sts in the same st

Λ = Decrease: Make 1 st from 2 consecutive sts

Back loop = work the st in back of loop only

BOW TIE (X1):

Using Amigurumi 100% Cotton in red (S04) and size D3 hook:

Rows	Stitches to be worked	Total stitches
Start	22 ○	22
1	20t (starting in the third ○ from the hook) Turn work	20
2	2○ to start the work + 20 t ● to close	20

Cut yarn leaving a long thread to sew with later.

Wrap yarn around the middle of the rectangle to make the bow tie.

JOINING THE PIECES:

1) Handle. Attach a thread at the 10th st from the start of the row and work 20 ○ . Work **x** in st number 38, turn work and make **x** in st number 37 so that the handle is firmly secured. Work **x** in each chain st and join with **x** in st number 11 ● and fasten off.

2) Position the bow tie centrally between the two ears and sew to basket .

3) Tail. Make a small pom pom using Big Ribbon Plus (103) and sew to the back of the basket.
